## Spring 2014 Gardening Projects Line-up: Volunteer Opportunities!

- ▶ **Pruning** the two large Crepe myrtles (mid to late winter);
- ▶ **Continuous weeding;**
- ▶ **Planting** new shrubs and perennials to fill in bare spots; and,
- ▶ **Creating/planting a Butterfly Garden:** a bed to attract butterflies, bees and moths. This population of important insects will attract others to help round out this mini-environment!



**The many hours provided by volunteers has made the rehabilitation of the DRA Gardens possible.** There is a constant (most seasons) need for volunteer help, both individually (I can show you what to do) and as a group. **The new butterfly garden has been enlarged** by lots of digging and weeding to loosen the soil for spring planting. See photo of the bare area surrounding the birdhouse back by the fence. Notice the edging and new mulch in

all the beds. A row of mini boxwood were donated and are framing the garden across the front of the gallery. Heavy pruning of some large, overgrown shrubs are a new improvement to opening up the views of the gallery show signs, while addressing some insect pest problems. Weeding is a constant need. Many of the perennials have been transplanted to remove invasive weeds from their root balls while reorganizing the arrangement of the plantings. Vigilance on removing leaves and other debris helps the gardens maintain a pleasant environment for the community.

February 7 – March 2, 2014

They say one man's trash is another's treasure. Here at Del Ray Artisans, we say it is an artist's invitation! We cordially invite you to re-imagine, recycle, re-think, re-use, repurpose, re-invent and redesign something otherwise headed for the landfill for this juried exhibit. Artists are called to submit 2-D and 3-D artwork created from discarded or found objects with at least a hint of its original form(s) recognizable. These *juried* works will be displayed together with *Artcyclopedias*, an altered encyclopedia book exhibit. Previously, several artists accepted the *Artcyclopedias* challenge to artistically alter volumes from a set of encyclopedias for a special display within this exhibit.

#### Entry Details:

- Receiving takes place **Sunday, Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>** and **Monday, Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup> from 6-8pm.**
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. The entry fee for Del Ray Artisans members is \$5 or \$10 for up to 3 pieces. The non-member fee is \$10 for 1<sup>st</sup> piece and \$5 each additional piece. (Entry fees for *Artcyclopedias* submissions are not required, but donations are greatly appreciated.)
- Space will be limited as many 3-D pieces are expected. Due to space limits, the curator and/or juror reserve the right to accept based on size and exhibit constraints.
- Please include a brief statement regarding media, materials used, and your process for each piece you submit.
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See [www.thedelrayartisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html](http://www.thedelrayartisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html) for details.
- When your art sells, you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax-deductible) to *Del Ray Artisans*.

#### Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, as well as delivery of sold work.
- **All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer** with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars/PDAs so you can sign up for duties at receiving. We'll also ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph artwork for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a Del Ray Artisans show.

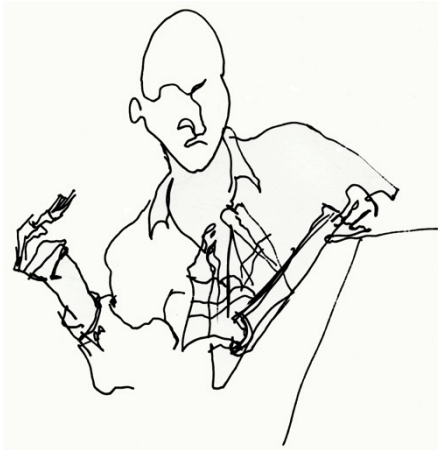

## Open Life Drawing Sessions – 2014

Looking for a chance to hone your figure drawing skills? Del Ray Artisans offers a range of open life drawing sessions for just this purpose. These sessions operate on a drop-in basis so there is no need to register in advance. Bring your supplies and join us at the gallery to draw or paint our live models. We don't supply easels - only plenty of chairs - but you are welcome to bring your own if you want to use one. All skill levels are welcome.



### ***Gesture Sessions (two hours)***

Come to the gesture sessions to loosen up and participate in a fun, fast-paced drawing experience. These two-hour sessions are composed primarily of dynamic 1 to 5 minute poses. Occasionally we throw in a continuous motion drawing exercise to keep things interesting.

### ***Short Pose Sessions (two hours)***

Short pose sessions predominantly feature poses lasting 5 to 15 minutes. These sessions are a wonderful way to get in lots of drawing practice with a wide variety of poses.

### ***Short/Long Pose Sessions (three hours)***

The three-hour short/long pose sessions start with some short 1 to 5 minute warm-up poses and progressively move into longer poses lasting 10 to 45 minutes. These sessions provide a great opportunity to hone your drawing and observation skills.

### ***Long Pose Sessions (three hours)***

If you want to spend an extended amount of time on a pose, come to our long pose sessions. These sessions are generally composed of two long poses with perhaps a few warm-ups at the start. *Please no acrylics or oils; pastels, watercolor and ink are welcome.*



The fee for each three-hour session is \$10 for DRA members and \$12 for non-members. Two-hour sessions are \$8 for members and \$10 for non-members.
