Dream On!

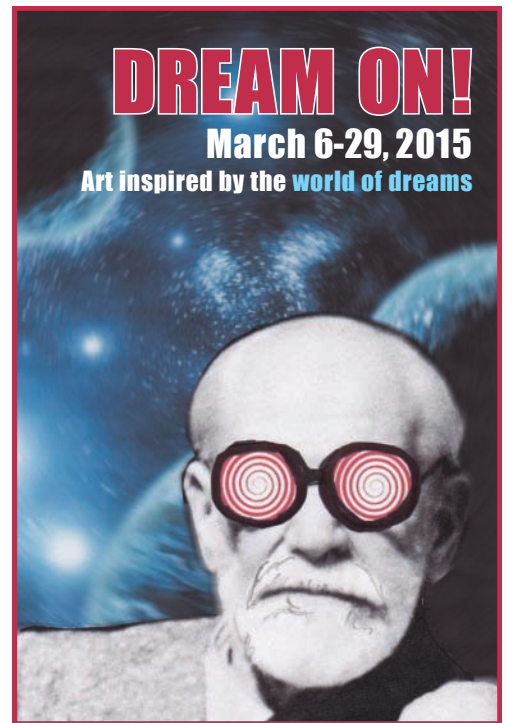
It is a happy New Year but it IS winter which still means short days and longer nights! Longer nights = more sleep. More sleep = more DREAMS!!!!
