Entry Details:

- Receiving takes place Sunday, April 26 and Monday, April 27 from 6-8pm.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for Del Ray Artisans Members and \$10 per piece for Non-Members. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- There is an additional **MIX Marketplace** where participating artists can sell Art-to-Go. Fees for art priced at: \$1 - \$30 is \$2 for 5 pieces (10 item limit); \$31 - \$70 is \$1 each (5 item limit); \$71 and over is \$2 each (5 item limit).
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for details.
- When your art sells, you are asked to make a 20% tax-deductible donation to Del Ray Artisans.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements.
- **All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer** with postcard distribution, set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. We'll ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a Del Ray Artisans show.
- Any artwork left over 30 days after the close of the show will become property of Del Ray Artisans.

BUILDING BRIDGES

June 5-28, 2015

Opening Reception: Friday, June 5 from 7-9pm

Building Bridges is a juried show between Del Ray Artisans and Six Degrees Consortium open to Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members and invited Mississippi Gulf Coast artists.

Building bridges between cultures is increasingly important in our ever-shrinking world. Empathy and understanding become possible when one individual reaches across cultural barriers to touch another person's life in some meaningful way. Artists entering this show are asked to visually interpret the building of bridges between peoples and cultures. Imagine a meeting between a peace activist and a refugee; a conversation between peoples of different religions; a playground filled with children from different countries. Artists may interpret this concept either thematically or literally in any medium.

Guest curator Lori K. Gordon is a visual artist, writer, Founder and President of Six Degrees Consortium, a Mississippi-based 501(c) 3 organization dedicated to the creation and dissemination of socially significant visual art. The Consortium is dedicated to the idea that visual art can be a powerful means of education and cross-cultural understanding. Ms. Gordon also envisions *Building Bridges* as recognition of Del Ray Artisans' member assistance to Mississippi artists following Hurricane Katrina, which devastated the Mississippi Gulf Coast 10 years ago.

- **Eligibility:** Show is open to Del Ray Artisans members and invited Mississippi Gulf Coast artists.
- **Receiving:** Sunday, May 31 from 6-8pm and Monday, June 1 from 6-8pm.
- **Entry fee:** \$5 per piece for members; artists may submit up to 2 pieces.
- **Display Guidelines:** 2D artwork only with a maximum size of 24" x 36".
- **Hanging:** All must be ready to hang (wire/screw eyes; no clip frames). Work not meeting requirements will not be accepted. See: www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/ArtGuidelines for guidelines.
