SALES The label affixed to each work shall indicate a pre-determined sales price or the words' "Not for sale." All sales will be by arrangement between the prospective buyer and the artist. Artists are responsible for collecting Virginia sales tax. Determined price may not be changed once the exhibit begins. Sold artwork must remain in the exhibit until the end of the show.

LIABILITY Senior Services of Alexandria, Goodwin House Foundation, The Art League, Inc., The Alexandria Commission on Aging, Friends of the Torpedo Factory Art Center, RSVP, The Alexandria Commission for the Arts, and/or The City of Alexandria cannot be held responsible for damage or theft of the exhibited work. Entering the show constitutes agreement with the above conditions. All unclaimed artwork will be charged a storage fee of \$50.00 per weekday.

WARRANTY The Lender/Artist warrants that s/he is the creator of and holds full and clear title to the Objects/Artwork to be exhibited.

ARTIST'S AGREEMENT Artists must deliver and pick up art work on the dates and times indicated on the Entry Form. Accepted work must be left in the exhibit until January 20, 2011. Artists agree to grant permission for their artwork to be photographed for publicity purposes.

RETURN OF ARTWORK Objects/Artwork will be returned to the Lender/Artist at The Durant Arts Center, 1605 Cameron Street, Alexandria, Virginia from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, on Friday, January 21, 2011. If legal ownership or authority to act in behalf of the legal owner should change, whether by reason of sale, death, gift, or otherwise, the new owner or agent may be required to establish a legal right to receive the Objects/Artwork by satisfactory proof. If the Lender/Artist fails to take possession of the Objects/Artwork and if efforts to contact the Lender/Artist or Owner at the expiration of the loan period are unsuccessful, the Objects/Artwork will be placed in storage at the Lender/Artist or Owner's risk and expense. If after one year the property is not reclaimed, it then shall become an unrestricted gift to Senior Services of Alexandria.

The 24th annual *YOUNG AT ART* show opens on Monday, October 4, 2010 at The Durant Arts Center, 1605 Cameron Street and runs through Thursday, January 20, 2011. The *YOUNG AT ART* Opening Reception and Awards Ceremony will be held on Thursday, October 14, 2010 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., also at The Durant Arts Center.

The juried show is open to all metro artists ages 55 and older. Carol Lukitsch of Alexandria, Virginia will serve as the juror. Ms. Lukitsch taught painting, drawing, and design for more than twenty years at colleges and universities including The Pennsylvania State University, The University of Maryland, Trinity College, and Northern Virginia Community College. Her teaching career culminated in a two-year Fulbright Grant to Turkey, where she lectured and taught at Bilkent University in Ankara. From 2003 through 2007, she was the Director of Exhibitions and Curator at The Arlington Arts Center in Arlington, VA.

Ms. Lukitsch's paintings and mixed media works have been exhibited in the United States, France, Italy, Germany, The Czech Republic, China, Africa, Paraguay, Panama, Russia, Lithuania, Turkey, and Israel. She has held residencies at The Millay Colony in New York, The Hilai Center in Israel, and The Virginia Center for Creative Arts. Her work is in collections including The Museum of Contemporary Art, Montecatini, Italy; State Museum of Painting and Sculpture, Ankara, Turkey; and The National Museum of Women in the Arts, Washington, DC.

YOUNG AT ART has consistently attracted accomplished artists who work in all mediums. Works by teachers, professionals, and amateurs have been submitted and accepted.

This is the third year that Senior Services of Alexandria (SSA) and Goodwin House Foundation (GHF) have co-sponsored the show. When "RSVP" (Retired Senior Volunteer Program) was looking for a new sponsor for the show in 2008, both Goodwin House Foundation and Senior Services of Alexandria were at the ready. "We are delighted to work with SSA, and carry on the tradition of RSVP's desire to showcase the works of talented older local artists," said Jeanne Jacob, Executive Director of Goodwin House Foundation.

Additional support for *YOUNG AT ART* is being provided by RSVP, The Art League, Inc., Alexandria Commission for the Arts, Alexandria Commission on Aging, and Friends of the Torpedo Factory Art Center.

The fee for entering is: \$25 for the first three entries and \$15 for each additional entry. All art media are accepted. - ENTRY** Open to original works of art, artwork must not have been entered in prior *YOUNG AT ART*
- REQUIREMENTS** exhibits. Two-dimensional works must be framed and matted if appropriate, and be wired and ready to hang.
- HOW TO ENTER** Complete the attached Entry Form and submit it with the artwork upon delivery to The Durant Arts Center. An entry fee of \$25.00 per artist covers up to three works of art. Additional works may be submitted with a fee of \$15.00 each. Checks only, please, made payable to Senior Services Alexandria. Entry fees are non-refundable.
