Call for Entries: All Member Show January 7 to January 30, 2011

An art show to celebrate and remember all things good and bad about winter. After last year's endless snowy season, remembering might be the last thing on your mind, but pull out your "once in a lifetime" Snowmageddon photos or work inspired by the power of the storms. Recall fond memories of warm and cozy fires or other winter's delights. Whatever your choice, show off your best works and help us support *Sock it to Winter* by donating a pair of new men's or women's socks to the homeless with each work of art that you enter. The homeless are at great risk to the elements and you can help keep them warm and dry this winter.

Opening Reception: Friday, 1/07/11, 7 pm to 10 pm
Unsold Artwork Pickup: Sunday 1/30/11, 6 pm to 8 pm

Entry Details:


- Show is open to all DRA members in good standing.
- Entry fees: \$3.00 per piece plus one pair new socks for DRA members.
- Submit any type of visual art or installation piece keeping with a winter theme. Contact curator for large or unusual pieces.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork; DRA members are entitled to have at least one piece of art displayed if submission criteria are met. Acceptance is at the Curator's discretion.
- Pieces must be ready to hang (with screw eyes and wire) or ready for display (with mounting and/or a display stand if necessary) or ready for installation (to the wall or ceiling).
- Artists may enter art not for sale (NFS) or priced to sell. When art sells, artist makes a 20% tax deductible donation to Del Ray Artisans.
- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, and delivery of sold work.
- ALL artists MUST gallery sit. A sign-up sheet is available at Artwork Receiving.
- The show closes on Sunday, January 30. **All artists MUST pick up their remaining artwork from the gallery between 6 pm and 8 pm on Sunday, January 30.**

Fine Print:

- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
